## Maryland 4A Boys' Final

**Who:** No. 2 Springbrook vs. No. 12 Wise.

**When:** 8 p.m., Comcast Center.

**Records:** Springbrook 26-0; Wise 21-5.

**What to look for from Springbrook:** The Blue Devils rely heavily on standout forward Jamal Olasewere (28 points, 14 rebounds in a double-overtime semifinal victory over Walbrook) but they are far from a one-player team. Guard Jeremy Williams has made big shots and there is plenty of size inside with 6-5 Brandon Davis and 6-6 Kwambina Coker. Reserves Zaid Hearst and Deshaunt Walker also are key players.

**What to look for from Wise:** The Pumas like to push the ball, with guards Phil Wood and David Golladay very capable scorers. Their key player is center Delonta Boyd, who can play inside but also can shoot the three-pointer. Wise has trailed in the fourth quarter of its past two games before rallying to win.

**Intangibles:** The game pits two schools with different basketball pedigrees. Wise is in its third year of existence and is coming off its first region championship. Springbrook, riding a 35-game winning streak, has won three state titles and is trying to become the first Maryland 4A repeat champion in 41 years.
